IN THE HALLWAY	
<i>Instead of saying this...</i>	<i>Say this...</i>
Stop running	"Please walk. We expect students to behave in a safe and courteous manner in the hallway."
Stop Yelling	"Please use an appropriate voice level. Using an quiet voice is respectful to others."
Don't be late again	"Show dedication to your studies and respect to your teachers and classmates by being to class on time. Why do you think its important that you are on time for class?"
IN THE BATHROOM	
<i>Instead of saying this</i>	<i>Say this</i>
Stop playing around in the bathroom.	Let's look at this poster together; what are the expectations in the bathroom. Were you following the expectations? What could you do differently?
Stop using so many paper towels and making a mess.	"Please be respectful and use two paper towels and make sure that they end up in the garbage. Thanks".
Don't use the bathroom during class	"Lets make sure that we are showing dedication to our studies by using the restroom at the appropriate time".
IN THE LUNCAROOM	
<i>Instead of saying this</i>	<i>Say this</i>
Clean up your mess	"Please demonstrate responsibility and leave no trace".
Be quiet	"Please follow lunchroom expectations; you are responsible for helping to keep the volume at a reasonable level".
TECHNOLOGY	
<i>Instead of saying this</i>	<i>Say this</i>
Don't leave your iPad in your locker	"Please demonstrate responsibility by ensuring that your iPad is attended to at all time. Where is the safest place for your iPad right now?"
Get used to it	"We need to have a positive attitude and adapt to change. Lets see if we can figure this out together".
No cheating	"Please demonstrate integrity by doing your own work. It is important that we are each responsible for our own learning".
